If only transformation for our beneficiaries was that easy. Just desire to leave the streets, make a fresh commitment, resolve to be different, shed a few tears, finish rehab and voila, out comes an empowered exdrug addict, ex-con woman/man, and a spiritually mature person.

To the contrary, the experience of many of our beneficiaries is not that easy. The decision to just leave the streets is huge and hard. Managing to stay at the center, to finish the rehab process without a single relapse is very challenging. To see our beneficiaries move from one level to another is something we do not take lightly. It is a miracle. As our supporter, this is a beautiful journey that you are part of and once again, we thank you for being part of the amazing things God is doing through us.

HOPE FOR WINNIE

Last month, we featured Winnie's story and the miracle of her healing from HIV/AIDS. When we highlighted her story, she was still living on the streets with her new born baby. She has since left and has joined the rest of the women at the Transformation Center.

Currently, she is at Dr. Joe's —our consulting psychiatrist for medical and psychotherapeutic treatment to help her overcome dependency on drugs. Treatment includes counseling by experts, prayer and sharing of experience with others going through the same process through a 12-step program.

We continue to pray for Winnie and her baby. She says that she loves the center and is happy that her baby is no longer sleeping in the cold. There is hope. There is light after a long season of darkness
